You can bring your registration fee to the February or March PGS Meeting or the day of the workshop.

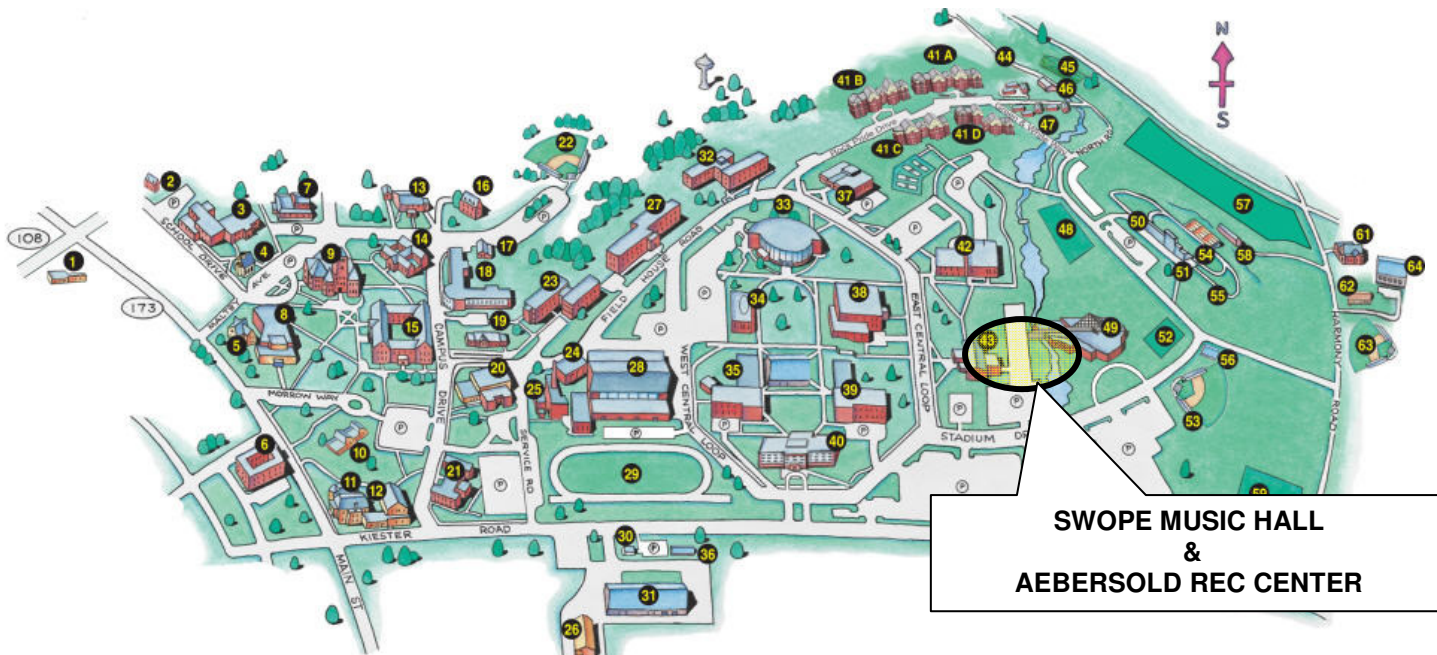
PLEASE CONTACT US TO SAVE YOUR PLACE REGARDLESS OF WHEN YOU DECIDE TO PAY
